Title : Order 'influencing juvenile behaviour'
Issued to : The Secretary of State for Justice
Date : 19 October 2007

The Council agrees to the Order 'influencing juvenile behaviour'. The Council does not have any additions to the contents of the Order. The Order makes a clear distinction between the special conditions that apply when pre-trial detention is suspended and when a conditional punishment or measure is imposed and the way in which a measure that influences behaviour may be put into effect. The Council emphasizes that the juvenile probation service can only perform its tasks when financial resources are available.

On 22 November 2004, the Council did provide advice on the Bill 'influencing juvenile behaviour'.
