Educational Order for Juveniles

The *Council for the Administration of Criminal Justice and Protection of Juveniles* is positive on the implementation of the new educational order, the detention under education order. Getting education increases the chances of convicted young persons on the labour market and thus decreases the chances of recidivism. Especially the immediate execution and the admission obligation for schools increase the chance of a successful education and thus have added value.

The introduction of this separate order would not have been necessary according to the Council for the Administration of Criminal Justice and Protection of Juveniles. The admission obligation could also have been implemented under the education obligation as part of the behaviour influencing order or the education obligation, which can be imposed as a special condition in the conditional sentence to a juvenile sanction. The Council understands however that there is the political will to come to the implementation of a new educational order. That is why the Council makes a number of proposals for adjustment and supplementation of the educational order in the field of especially diagnostics, the target group, the admission obligation for schools, suitable education and the concurrence with other orders.
